## APPLICATION

Apply liberally by means of a brush with an agitating motion. Allow the DEGREASING SOLVENT to stand for 2 to 3 minutes; keep wet contact and do not allow to dry out. Thoroughly rinse with copious amounts of clean water whilst scrubbing the surface or alternatively high pressure water wash. Test for water break-free surface and repeat if necessary. Treat small areas at a time to allow for better control.

Please note: Take care as SABRE DEGREASING SOLVENT may damage existing acrylic coatings and plant growth.
